



IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THE 30th Annual Taste of Morgan Hill September 28-29, 2019

Dear Downtown Morgan Hill Businesses & Residents:

Planning is underway for the 30th Annual "Taste of Morgan Hill" being held Saturday & Sunday, September 28-29, 2019. As the organizers of the "Taste of Morgan Hill" our goal is to focus on supporting, promoting and showcasing the Morgan Hill Community.

The "Taste of Morgan Hill" takes place Downtown on Monterey Road from Main to Dunne Avenues and the associated side streets. The festival attracts approximately 50,000 people over the two-day event.

STREET CLOSURES *beginning Friday, September 27th at 9pm until Sunday, September 29th till 10pm:*

- Monterey Road between Main & Dunne Avenues
- West 1st Street, 2nd Street, 4th Street & 5th Streets at Monterey Road (public parking lots open)
- West 3rd Street closed at 3pm at bridge for Stage (no access to parking lots)
- East 1st Street, 2nd Street, 4th Street & 5th Streets at Monterey (public parking lots open including Community Center)
- East 3rd Street closed for food court (all residents will have access to their homes via Depot Street.

DOWNTOWN BUSINESSES: We would love for you to take advantage of this great opportunity to showcase your business by encouraging you to display your merchandise on the sidewalk in front of your business or store front and be open for business both Saturday and Sunday during the festival.

DOWNTOWN FOOD & BEVERAGE ESTABLISHMENTS: Any food sold outdoors during this event must have a temporary event health permit issued by Santa Clara County Department of Environmental Health. **No beverages are allowed to be sold or given away outside of your place of business.** For a Temporary Event Health Permit, please contact the Santa Clara County Department of Health at 408-918-3400. **The Health Department will be onsite at the festival to check permits.**

PLEASE NOTE: Due to city permitting and insurance requirements, all downtown businesses must stay on the sidewalk. If you wish to be on the street, you can download the vendor application at www.morganhill.org. You may only display merchandise and/or services normally carried inside your physical premises. You may not give or sell rights to that space to others. If you do, they will be asked to leave. **NO EXEPTIONS!**
